

## UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-GREEN BAY EDUCATION PROGRAM LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

A license issued under this section authorizes an individual to teach grades Kindergarten through 9 in a regular education setting. Individuals may teach any subject, except world language in a self-contained classroom, or Language Arts, Math, Science or Social Studies in a departmentalized setting.

**Prior to Full Admission to the Program:****General Education Requirements**

- A minimum of 28 university level credits completed.

**Meet with your Professional Advisor****Communication Skills Competency (select 1):**

- Pass all three sections of the Praxis CORE  
 An ACT composite score of 23 or higher, with a min. of 20 in English, Math and Reading  
 Earn a "C" or better in approved coursework in Mathematics, English Composition, and English.
