#### **Post-Graduation Success**

Low student-loan default rates signal that students find employment and are fiscally responsible; the most recent three-year default rate for the Federal Student Aid program is 7.7%, compared to 9.7% nationally. #### Recruiting and Retaining Faculty

In 2019–20, UW–Green Bay offered faculty positions to 24 candidates, with 17 accepted offers (70.83%). On average over the past 5 years, 67% of offers to faculty candidates were accepted. In 2019-2020, full professor salaries were 27.4% below the median for faculty at peer institutions as reported in the 2020 IPEDS report. #### Research Funds

UW-Green Bay is investing in the research and sponsored projects enterprise to better support the research and sponsored project initiatives of its faculty, staff, students and administrators. External Funding (Research, Public Service, and Instruction Activity) has grown significantly in the past three years, increasing 68% from \$3,713,592 in 2018 to \$6,259,610 in 2020.
