

## **Governance Actions** **March 2010 - May 2010**

### **The Curriculum**

#### **Program actions:**

Associate of Arts and Science Degree - change in natural science requirements to match those of general education for the Bachelor's degree, approved by Dean, AAC, and Provost for implementation in Fall 2010.

Business Administration - change in requirements for the minor from 13 credits to four courses for a minimum of 12 credits, approved by BUA Chair, Dean, AAC, and Provost for implementation in Fall 2010.

Geography - change in requirements for minor by adding GEOG 110 to a list of options, approved with the approval of the course (see below) for Fall 2010

Information Sciences - change requirements for major and minor deleting COMM 326 Modern Semantics and moving COMM 322 Modern Linguistics to the list of options for required upper-level courses, approved by ICS Chair, Dean, AAC, and Provost for Fall 2010.

Social Work - add SOC WORK 250 You and Your Future to a list of options for supporting courses in the major, approved by Social Work Chair, Dean, AAC, and Provost for Fall 2010.

ART 453 Advanced Textiles - minor change in prerequisites approved by AVD Chair and Dean.

BUS 497 Internship - minor change to allow for non-credit internships, approved by BUS Chair and Dean.

COMP SCI 483X Foundations of Computer Science - an experimental course approved by ICS Chair and Dean for Spring 2011.

GEOG 110 Introduction to Human Geography - new course approved by PEA Chair (and supported by URS Chair), Dean, GEC (for SS I gen ed), AAC, and Provost for Fall 2010.

HUD 198 Love and Lust in America - new course approved by HUD Chair, Dean, and GEC (for writing emphasis and SS II).

HUD 353 Family Development - minor change removing writing emphasis status, approved by HUD Chair and Dean.

HUD 544 Dying, Death and Loss - new course approved by HUD Chair, Dean, AAC, and Provost for Fall 2010.

HUS all courses crosslisted with First Nations Studies no longer have a cross listed number in HUS (requirements are unaffected) - a minor change approved by FNS Chair, HUS Chair, and Dean for Fall 2010.
