ESL and BILINGUAL



ESL TEACHERS

An ESL (English as a Second Language) teacher helps develop and reinforce competence in English and emphasizes the mastery of English language skills. ESL teachers demonstrate and teach these skills for students whose second language is English.

ESL/BILINGUAL TEACHERS

An ESL/Bilingual Teacher teaches in the students' native language, most often Spanish. The Bilingual teacher is proficient in both English and the native language.

LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

GPA of 3.0 in licensure courses, OR Praxis II Exam #5362 English to Speakers of Other Languages.
18-weeks student teaching. Undergraduate students only.

Additional licensure requirements for Bilingual-Bicultural

Oral and written language proficiency in language of certification through the LTI Exam.
