## Minutes of previous meeting

The draft minutes of the preceding meeting, held in October '22, were amended to clarify the amount and nature of the three Retiree Association Scholarship awards made recently.

## **Discussion items**

--With regard to Retiree Association-organized outings and special events, President Spielmann shared that the Weidner Center was willing to offer retiree members a discount of \$5 off on a selected show or concert in association with a Retiree Association reception/outing.

--Phoenix Athletics would likewise be willing to extend a group rate or help arrange a pre- or post-game reception if the Retiree Association could identify a men's basketball game for an outing.

--There was some discussion about whether the Retiree Association, with currently at least a little operating money in the bank, might consider subsidizing a lower rate for retirees. Opinion was mixed on this idea.

--It was agreed that a basketball game and also a Weidner Center outing – perhaps to the upcoming Patsy Cline and George Jones tribute concert – would be decent choices for at least two Retiree Association events over the winter. Dan said he would follow up and notify retirees of any scheduled events.

--Craig Lockard shared that he had a recent conversation with the soon-to-be-retiring NAS Prof. Bob Howe about doing a presentation (on birds, habitat, ecology and the like) for a Retiree Association audience at some time in the future. It was agreed that this would likely be a topic of some general interest, and that we should pursue at a later (warmer weather) date.
