Payment Plan: Student accounts in SIS that are not paid in full by the term due date will automatically be placed on the payment plan. Charges may apply. Learn more at www.uwgb.edu/student-billing.

Parent Loan for Undergrad Student (PLUS): Federal loan available to a parent of an undergraduate, dependent student based on credit history. If a parent is denied the PLUS Loan, the student may be offered additional Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan. More information is available at www.uwgb.edu/financial-aid/plus.

Grad PLUS Loan: Federal loans available to degree-seeking students in a graduate program based on credit history. More information is available at www.uwgb.edu/financial-aid/plus.

Private Loan: Student (and sometimes parent) loan offered by many private lenders (e.g., banks, credit unions). The application process is done directly with the lender. Terms and conditions of the loan (e.g., interest rates) will vary by lender. Once approved, the lender will contact the school.

Students at UW-Green Bay have used many lenders to help fund their educational expenses. For a list of lenders our students have used over the last three years, see FASTChoice here www.uwgb.edu/financial-aid/private. Borrowers can choose to use any lender, including a lender not listed.
