

Resolution in favor of transparency and improvement in snow removal

Whereas, snow removal at the Green Bay Campus of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay has been outsourced to a third-party;

Whereas, the recent snow storm on February 22nd and 23rd (which though it left a large amount of snow, is not particularly exceptional in the amount of snow it left) has revealed that the snow removal system at the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay is inadequate and neglectful of both residential and commuter students;

Whereas, residential parking lots in particular have been sorely neglected, to the point where some have, as of writing (February 23, 2023 at 9:00 PM), been untouched or mostly untouched by any slow plow;

Whereas, even in the event of a moderate or light amount of snowfall, the roads and parking lots on campus have consistently taken several days afterward to improve to a level of drivability comparable to the roads off-campus;

Whereas, several faculty members have mentioned to the author that snow removal on this campus has not always been as it is currently;

Whereas, in addition to being a safety concern, a poor snow removal system is a significant financial liability for the University and owners of motor vehicles;

Whereas, the conditions of the sidewalks and roads on campus do not follow ADA regulations and pose a serious safety issue for able-bodied and disabled students and faculty/staff alike;

Therefore, be it resolved that this body strongly urges the University to reconsider and evaluate its system of snow removal, namely its practice of having outsourced it to a third-party



contractor, and whether it would be in this University's best interest to have further resources allocated to snow removal;

Be it further resolved that this body invites the individual in charge of overseeing snow removal on this campus to the next meeting of this body (March 20th, 2023) to announce how snow removal will by improved in light of the above facts, and to answer questions generally about snow removal;

Be it further resolved, that this body generally expresses its concern for the neglect of the residential and visitor areas of this campus;

Be it further resolved, that this body commends Provost Kate Burns for swiftly moving classes online for part of Wednesday, February 22 and all of Thursday, February 23;

Be it finally resolved, that this body requests a written report detailing snow removal at this campus and how it might be improved be delivered to it within a month after this resolution's passage.
