## Resolution to recognize the right and responsibility of SUFAC members to represent student views of auxiliary services and budgets

*Whereas,* Wisconsin Statutes, § 36.09(5), adopted in 1974, states: "The students of each institution or campus subject to the responsibilities and powers of the board, the president, the chancellor and the faculty shall be active participants in the immediate governance of and policy development for such institutions. As such, students shall have primary responsibility for the formulation and review of policies concerning student life, services and interests. Students in consultation with the chancellor and subject to the final confirmation of the board shall have the responsibility for the disposition of those student fees which constitute substantial support for campus student activities."

*Whereas,* the Segregated University Fee Allocation Committee (SUFAC) is made up of student representatives duly appointed in accordance with the bylaws of the SUFAC;

*Whereas,* the SUFAC, in the course of its duties under its bylaws and the Student Government Association constitution, carefully reviews and hears presentations regarding the auxiliary budgets of the University of Wisconsin – Green Bay;

*Whereas,* SUFAC serves as the first expression of student opinion and representation regarding these budgets and the just use of segregated university fee (SUF) funds;

*Whereas,* as student representatives, SUFAC members have the right to express their opinion and the responsibility to represent the opinions of fellow students in the immediate governance of and policy development for the University of Wisconsin – Green Bay; furthermore, SUFAC members are active participants in the formulation and review of policies concerning student life, services and interests, as is consistent with Wisconsin Statutes, § 36.09(5);

*Therefore, be it resolved,* that the student senate finds that SUFAC, especially owing to their direct involvement and expertise in the presentation of auxiliary budgets, be rightfully encouraged to express student opinion with all means and manner in which SUF funds are spent through auxiliary budgets.
