

Resolution for Transparency: Distance Education Course Fees

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Cosponsors:

Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay has been made aware of student concerns related to the allocation of distance education course fees,

Whereas: Regarding distance education course fees, the Student Billing Resources page on the UW-Green Bay website states the following:

"These funds will be used to:

- 1. Cover the costs associated with purchasing and maintaining the software that is used to develop and deliver distance education courses
- 2. Cover the costs of state authorization fees for distance delivery
- 3. Offset the costs of staffing student support services (e.g. Instructional Design, IT Service Desk, Library, Advising, Tutoring, etc.)
- 4. Cover the costs associated with purchasing or licensing online library resources
- 5. Provide specialized training to faculty and teaching academic staff who develop, deliver, and/or support distance education courses
- 6. Promote the development of new distance education programs,"

Whereas: While the allocation of distance education course fees is outlined on the UW-Green Bay website, students report concerns and a lack of awareness regarding where funds from distance education course fees are allocated,

Whereas: Students report a desire for increased communication regarding distance education course fees;

Therefore, be it resolved: The Student Government Association of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay calls for UW-Green Bay, in collaboration with the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay Student Billing Resources department, to release, to all UW-Green Bay students, a disclosure of where funds from distance education course fees are allocated;





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Therefore, be it finally resolved: The areas to which distance education course fees are allocated shall be displayed and/or linked on the Student Information System (SIS) website during the student payment process, and/or in an email to students regarding payments.
