

Childcare Pilot Resolution

Whereas the UWGB Childcare Establishment Fund is consistent with the University of Wisconsin - Green Bay mission and meets the needs of many students and

Whereas the UWGB Childcare Establishment Fund is intended to provide financial assistance in the establishment of child care support for University of Wisconsin - Green Bay students and

Whereas The UWGB Childcare Establishment Fund is developed to respond to the demand for childcare presented by the student body, and

Whereas UW-Green Bay is without any form of child care support so parents are able to attend courses and fully engage in their education as needed, and

Whereas creation of a childcare reimbursement program is supported by the Equity and Diversity Committee.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Student Government Association will provide an initial fund of \$16,000 from the Child care fund to be made available for partial reimbursement of student childcare needs.

Be it further resolved students are eligible if they are enrolled in 6 or more credits at the Green Bay Campus.

Be it further resolved the reimbursement rate for fulltime students will be 50%, for 9 credits 33% and 25% for 6 credits.

Be it further resolved reimbursements will be capped at \$125 per week per child.

Be it further resolved student will be required to complete an application form each semester in order to gather the necessary information for managing the program.

Be it further resolved the Childcare provider must be a licensed facility.

Be it further resolved the program would not cover deposits, supplies, or misc. fees.
