Family Agreement for Partnership Program Tuition

The Green Bay Area Public Schools (GBAPS) partners with UW-Green Bay (UWGB) for the Rising Phoenix program. Students may earn college credit in the program through dual credit courses offered in GBAPS high schools or UWGB courses taken through the Early College Credit Program (ECCP).

GBAPS will:

- Pay the costs for tuition and required course materials for all GBAPS dual credit courses.
- Pay the costs for tuition and required course materials for courses through the Early College Credit Program up to 18 college credits as described in Board of Education policy 343.46. Students may take courses beyond 18 credits; however, the student and/or parent or guardian will be responsible for all associated costs.

Parents/Guardians and Students - acknowledge the following:

- The school district has agreed to pay the tuition and cost of required resources for dual credit courses. These are courses taught by university approved GBAPS High School teachers.
- The school district has agreed to pay for the first 18 credits of UWGB courses under the ECCP program. I and/or my parents/guardians will be responsible for paying tuition, materials, and fees for any credits over 18.
 - I will pay the estimated cost of tuition and resources to GBAPS before the UWGB courses begin.
 - If the actual cost is greater than what was estimated, I agree to pay the difference.
 - If the actual cost is lower than what was estimated, GBAPS will refund me the difference.
- I understand that these courses will become part of my permanent UW-Green Bay record and may affect my subsequent eligibility for admission to postsecondary institutions.
- I authorize the high school and UW-Green Bay to provide and exchange information about course registration, grades, and attendance as needed for educational purposes.
